Emergency Medical Form: A pre-populated EMF for your student has been included in this mailing. Please take some time to carefully review the auto-call information/phone number at the top of the form and also the contact information in the center. If you find there are changes to be made, please mark them directly on the form. **Your student can drop off their completed Emergency Medical Form when they pick up their parking pass or they can turn it in on the first day of school. Please DO NOT return to coaches/directors/athletic trainers.** We encourage you to make copies of the completed form as often times needs arise throughout the year for additional EMF's.

Schedule Changes: The ability to change schedules at this point in the year is extremely limited. *Schedule changes will only be permitted to accommodate courses that have been passed over the summer.*

Parking Pass Pickup: The Class of 2018 can pick-up their parking passes beginning Tuesday, August 1 at 1:00 pm. The Main Office will be open 7:30 am – 3:00 pm August 2 – August 10 for pick-up as well.

School Pictures: All seniors will get pictures taken for Student ID Cards on August 22. Families that want to purchase picture packages should watch the T-Hawk News for picture package information.

School Supplies: As you know, specific school supplies are driven by the courses taken. In other words, teachers will provide information about what you need for their class on the first day of school. All students should plan to bring a notebook and something to write with the first day.

Important Dates: In an effort to help you plan for the upcoming school year, we have included an "Important Dates" flyer in this mailing. Dates are accurate as of July 24, 2017 but are subject to change as needed throughout the year.

2017-2018 Bell Schedule

Lakota East Main Campus will continue to utilize the Modified Block Schedule for the 2017-2018 school year. The hours for the school day will be: 8:05 am – 2:40 pm. A copy of the modified block schedule is posted on the Lakota East High School homepage.

The modified block schedule includes a standard, six-bell schedule on Monday, Tuesday and Friday. Each bell will last approximately fifty minutes. There will be four lunch rotations during the fourth bell, during which students will have a 60-minute class, 30-minute lunch and a 30-minute intervention period.

On Wednesdays, students will meet in first, third and fifth bells for 95 minutes. On Thursdays, they will meet in second, fourth and sixth bells for 95 minutes. There will also be a 50-minute Extra Help Bell (XH) worked in between first and third periods on Wednesday/second and fourth periods on Thursday. This XH Bell will provide all students with the opportunity to receive additional intervention and enrichment.


Office Hours
