Lakota East Chapter Bylaws



2020-2021 Pandemic Bylaw Amendment

The NHS Faculty Council recognizes that the novel coronavirus pandemic has limited the opportunities for NHS members to meet the service requirement required in the bylaws. Consequently, a one-year amendment to the bylaw requirements is immediately effect, reducing the service requirement by 20%.

Under this amendment, the possible service configurations are

A. 24 NHS project hours (of which at least 4 must be NHS fundraising)

OR

B. 12 NHS Project Hours (of which at least 4 must be NHS fundraising)
12 school hours

OR

C. 12 NHS Project Hours (of which at least 4 must be NHS fundraising)
6 school hours
6 community hours

Notes

PROJECT hours are those organized, implemented, and supervised directly by the East chapter of NHS.

SCHOOL hours are those done in service to Lakota East High School and supervised by an East faculty member.

COMMUNITY hours allow individual members to do their own service projects, outside of the auspices of the school or the chapter.

NHS FUNDRAISING HOURS (Hours 12-15 on checklist) are hours spent raising funds for use by the Lakota East chapter of NHS.

Time spent raising funds for donation to other organizations counts as COMMUNITY HOURS or perhaps NHS PROJECT HOURS if NHS is the primary organizer.

Hours from school or community CANNOT BE SUBSTITUTED into the project hours category beyond what the Faculty Council has allowed here.
