NHS exists to foster and recognize the four tenets of scholarship, leadership, character, service. In keeping with the fine traditions of Lakota East NHS, eligible candidates for membership will meet the following criteria

- 1** Scholarship
Weighted Cumulative **GPA of 3.8** or higher by spring of junior year
- 2** Leadership
At least **two organizational leadership roles** held since start of grade 8
- 3** Service
30 service hours in at least **two different activities** since grade 8
- 4** Character
The NHS student of character has **a history of ethical behavior** and academic responsibility and complies with all school regulations regarding conduct

What is NHS?

NHS is a recognition bestowed by the Lakota East faculty. Unlike an award in math or English, this recognition comes with obligations that you are agreeing to meet should you accept membership.

What are the duties of an NHS member?

NHS designs a major project every year that serves the community or the school. You will be required to contribute 30 hours of your time to service that project.

What are my other obligations to NHS?

You must make yourself available when NHS calls on you. Certainly, you are required to attend the monthly general meetings. You must show yourself to be a leader in the Society.
