Guidelines

Four \$750 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors only.

Students may apply to more than one category, but only one scholarship will be awarded per student.

All applicants must submit the official application form to the Counseling Office by the stated deadline. (3/29/2023)

Students must meet the criterion listed below for any category of which they are applying.

DR. KLINE LEHS THUNDERHAWK SPIRIT SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. Student has participated in an activity/organization/event which has promoted the positive image of LEHS.
- 2. Student must explain how he/she has promoted positive Thunderhawk Spirit during high school time at Lakota East.
- 3. Student has maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better.

COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. Student has demonstrated community involvement in at least one project over his/her high school life. These may or may not involve Lakota East.
- 2. Student must document consistent time commitment to service throughout high school. Student should provide a reference to attest to this service.
- 3. Student has maintained a GPA of 2.5 or better.

EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. Student must be on IEP OR a 504 plan.
- 2. Student must have letter of reference from two teachers.
- 3. Student must have GPA at least 2.5 or better.

FIRST IN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. Neither parent has graduated from college.
- 2. Student has a specific career goal.
- 3. Evidence of employment (part time) and/or community service and/or extracurricular activities.
- 4. Student has maintained a GPA of at least 2.5 or better.
